From Downtown via Highway 17 (Johnnie Dodds Boulevard):

Take Highway 17 North and exit at Bowman Road. At stoplight, turn left onto Bowman Road. Take right onto Hospital Drive. Proceed 0.5 miles. Take left into East Cooper Medical Center parking lot.

From areas North of Town and Isle of Palms:

Turn right onto Mathis Ferry Road from Highway 17 and proceed approximately 0.7 miles to the Roundabout at Hospital Drive. Turn onto Hospital Drive. Continue past ER entrance and turn right into parking lot.

From North Charleston / I-526:

Take I-526 to Highway 17 (Exit 30 towards Charleston), merge right onto Hwy 17 and take Bowman Rd. exit. Take right at stoplight onto Bowman Rd. Take first right onto Hospital Drive. Proceed 0.5 miles. Take left into East Cooper Medical Center parking lot.

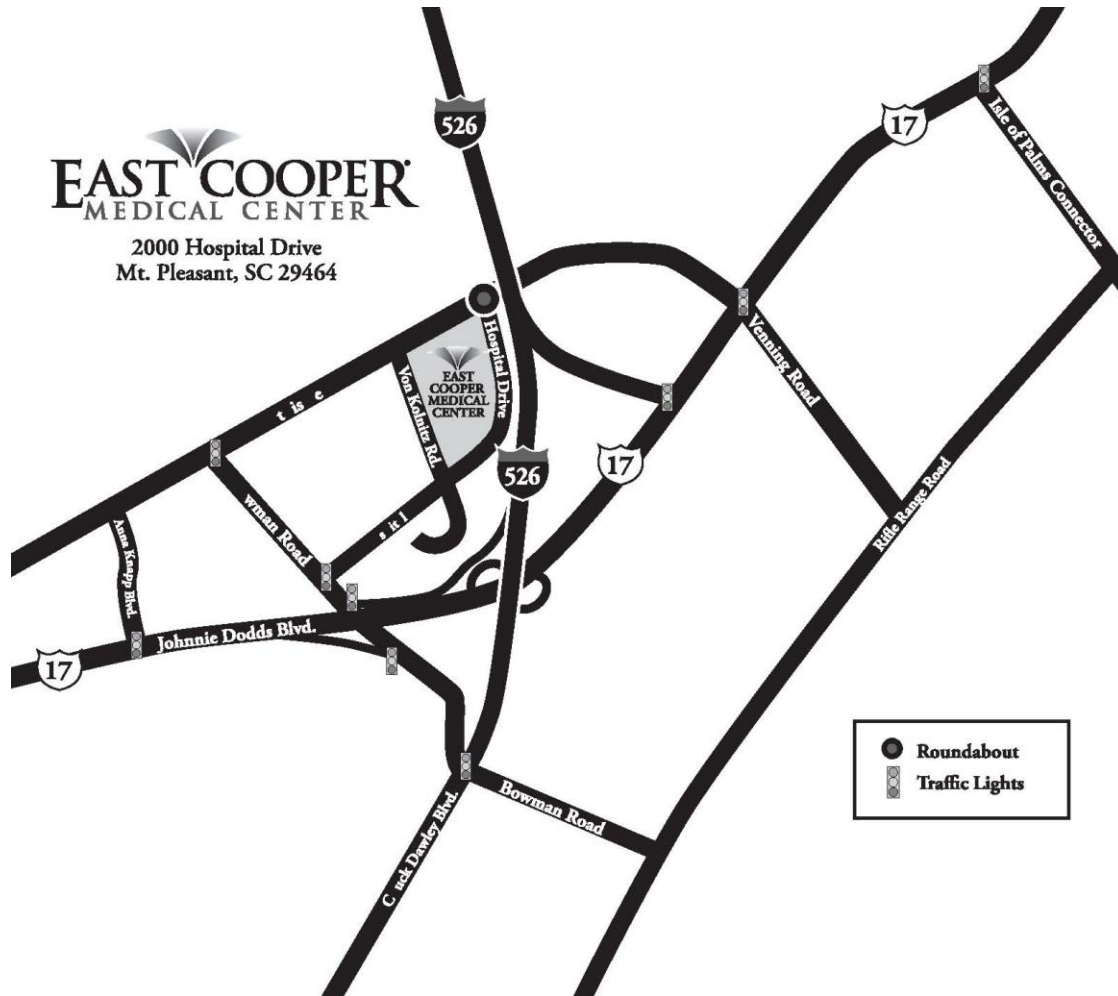
