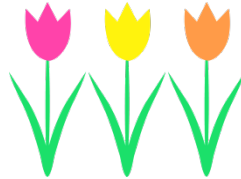

## ***SPEAKER BIOGRAPHIES***

### ***Thornton Kirby, FACHE***

Thornton Kirby is President and CEO of the South Carolina Hospital Association, a role he has held since 2005. Under Thornton's leadership, SCHA has been an advocate for patients as well as hospitals, earning a national reputation for statewide improvements in quality and safety. South Carolina was the first state to establish "Certified Zero Harm Awards", which are given annually to hospitals that can demonstrate at least 12 consecutive months without certain types of harm. Thornton attended the University of Virginia, where he studied government and interned for Senator Strom Thurmond. He studied law at the University of South Carolina and began his professional career as a healthcare attorney with the Nexsen Pruet law firm. After advising hospitals for several years, Thornton served as a hospital executive and later as a senior executive for Clemson University. In addition to his work in SC, Thornton currently services as Chairman of Joint Commission Resources and Joint Commission International.

### ***Stephanie Burgess, PhD, APRN, FNP-BC, FAANP***

Dr. Burgess is a Certified Family Nurse Practitioner. She received her BSN in 1975, MSN 1983, and PhD in 2003 from the University of South Carolina. Dr. Burgess teaches in the Nurse Practitioner program, Masters and DNP. She teaches NP clinical courses, health policy, and foundation NP courses. She also chairs doctoral projects. Dr. Burgess' research focuses on vulnerable populations.

Dr. Burgess has served in various leadership roles for several organizations including South Carolina Nurses Association, Sigma Theta Tau, the Statewide Coalition for Access to Healthcare. Those roles include President, Vice President, or Chair. She also was an elected official from 2004-2012.

Dr. Burgess is a FNP and provides primary care and women's health at two practices, including a Nurse Managed Healthcare Practice. Given her critical care background as RN, she also functions as a hospitalist NP.

### ***Terri Coburn, PMSM, CPHQ, CPCS***

Terri Coburn is CPMSM, CPHQ, and CPCS certified. She has served as a Faculty Instructor, Board Member, and Presenter at several NAMSS Annual Conferences. Terri is currently the Director of Medical Staff Services at East Cooper Medical Center in Mount Pleasant, SC. She has a bachelor's degree in Communications from Florida State University and over 17 years of experience in Medical Staff Services. Her hobbies include fishing and more fishing.

### ***Rick Foster, MD***

Dr. Rick Foster has served as a senior executive with SCHA for over 10 years, initially serving as Senior VP for Quality and Patient Safety. He also serves as medical director for Sharing Hope SC, the Organ Procurement Organization for South Carolina. Prior to joining SCHA, Rick served as chief medical officer for Trident Health System in Charleston, S.C. His primary responsibilities at SCHA include leading the work of the Alliance for a Healthier South Carolina and providing consultative services and technical assistance to SC organizations at the state and community levels committed to achieving the

**Rick's previous medical administrative experience includes service as chief executive officer of the Carolina Health Group, a provider network management company that acted as the management arm for three multi-specialty IPA Networks in the Coastal Region of South Carolina; and as the medical director of Companion Healthcare, the HMO subsidiary of Blue Cross Blue Shield of South Carolina.**

**Dr. Foster received his BS from Clemson University and his MD from the Medical University of South Carolina. He completed his residency in Family Medicine at Self Regional Healthcare in Greenwood, S.C., and was in the private practice of family medicine in Surfside Beach and Charleston prior to joining Companion Healthcare.**
